Now that you've been admitted, the next important step is to reserve your space in our incoming class by the date indicated in the enclosed letter. To accept your admission and pay your non-refundable \$200 tuition deposit, follow these steps:

- Log in to my.wsu.edu and click on "Student Center"
- Click the "Accept" link and follow the steps to pay your deposit

Need help creating and navigating your myWSU account?

Visit go.wsu.edu/myWSUinfo. myWSU is WSU's student information system where you can confirm your admission, view your financial aid package, and more.

APPLY for financial aid

To make sure you're considered for all forms of financial aid available, complete the 2016-2017 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) as soon as possible after January 1, 2016. Send the FAFSA by February 15, 2016 to meet the WSU priority date which ensures you'll be considered for grants, need-based loans, and work study. fafsa.gov

Use our financial aid estimator at estimator.wsu.edu to find out what types of financial aid you may be eligible to receive.

APPLY for scholarships

After you confirm your admission and pay the non-refundable \$200 tuition deposit, we'll send you more information about important steps to complete.

Two of these steps include:

- Signing up for university housing. Housing assignments are prioritized on a first come, first served basis. On-campus housing is required for all new freshmen under the age of 20 and highly encouraged for transfer students. housing.wsu.edu
- Registering for Alive! Orientation or Transfer Alive! (for transfer students) where you will meet with an academic advisor and register for classes. Orientation dates are assigned on a first come, first served basis. Orientation is required for all new students. alive.wsu.edu
